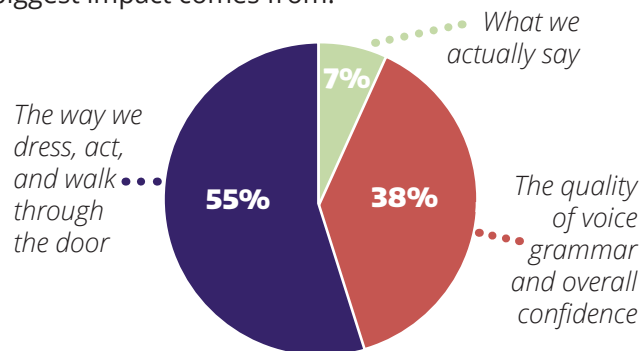

**47%** bosses say having *little to no knowledge of the company* is the most common mistake during interviews

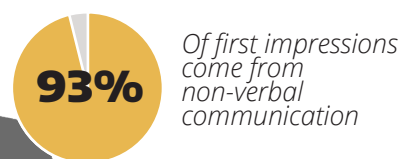
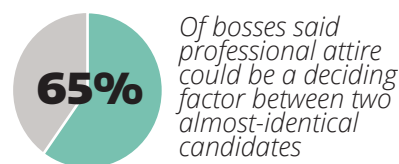
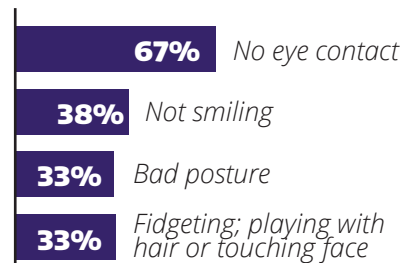
**Tell me about yourself** is the most likely interview question to be asked

## TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- > Research the organization and share why you are interested in the company
- > Come ready to talk about your strengths
- > Review your qualifications for the job and be specific about the position you wish to fill
- > Share stories that demonstrate your skills and experiences
- > Send a thank-you note within 24 hours
- > Be prepared to ask questions at the end of the interview
